FINAL JUDGMENT AS TO DEFENDANT ROCKEY HATFIELD

The Securities and Exchange Commission having filed a Complaint and Defendant Rockey "Roc" Hatfield, having entered a general appearance; consented to the Court's jurisdiction over Defendant and the subject matter of this action; consented to entry of this Final Judgment; waived findings of fact and conclusions of law; and waived any right to appeal from this Final Judgment:

I.

INCORPORATION OF JUDGMENT

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the Court's Judgment as to Defendant entered on February 20, 2018 [D.E. 24] is hereby adopted and incorporated by reference with the same force and effect as if fully set forth herein, and that Defendant shall comply with all of the undertakings and agreements set forth therein.

II.

DISGORGEMENT AND PREJUDGMENT INTEREST

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Defendant is liable for disgorgement of \$408,120, representing profits gained as a result of the conduct alleged in the Complaint, together with prejudgment interest thereon in the amount of \$46,492.83, but the total

of such disgorgement and prejudgment interest, \$454,612.83, is deemed satisfied by the entry of the \$3,714,469.00 restitution order entered on August 28, 2018, in *United States v. Rockey "Roc" Hatfield, et al.*, Crim. No. 17-CR-20676-JEM (S.D. Fla.).

III.

INCORPORATION OF CONSENT

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the Consent to Final Judgment is incorporated herein with the same force and effect as if fully set forth herein, and that Defendant shall comply with all of the undertakings and agreements set forth therein.

IV.

RETENTION OF JURISDICTION

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that this Court shall retain jurisdiction of this matter for the purposes of enforcing the terms of this Final Judgment.
