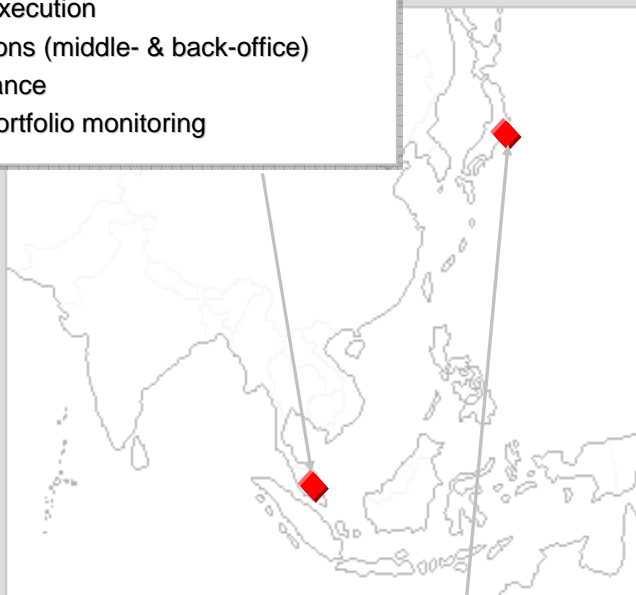

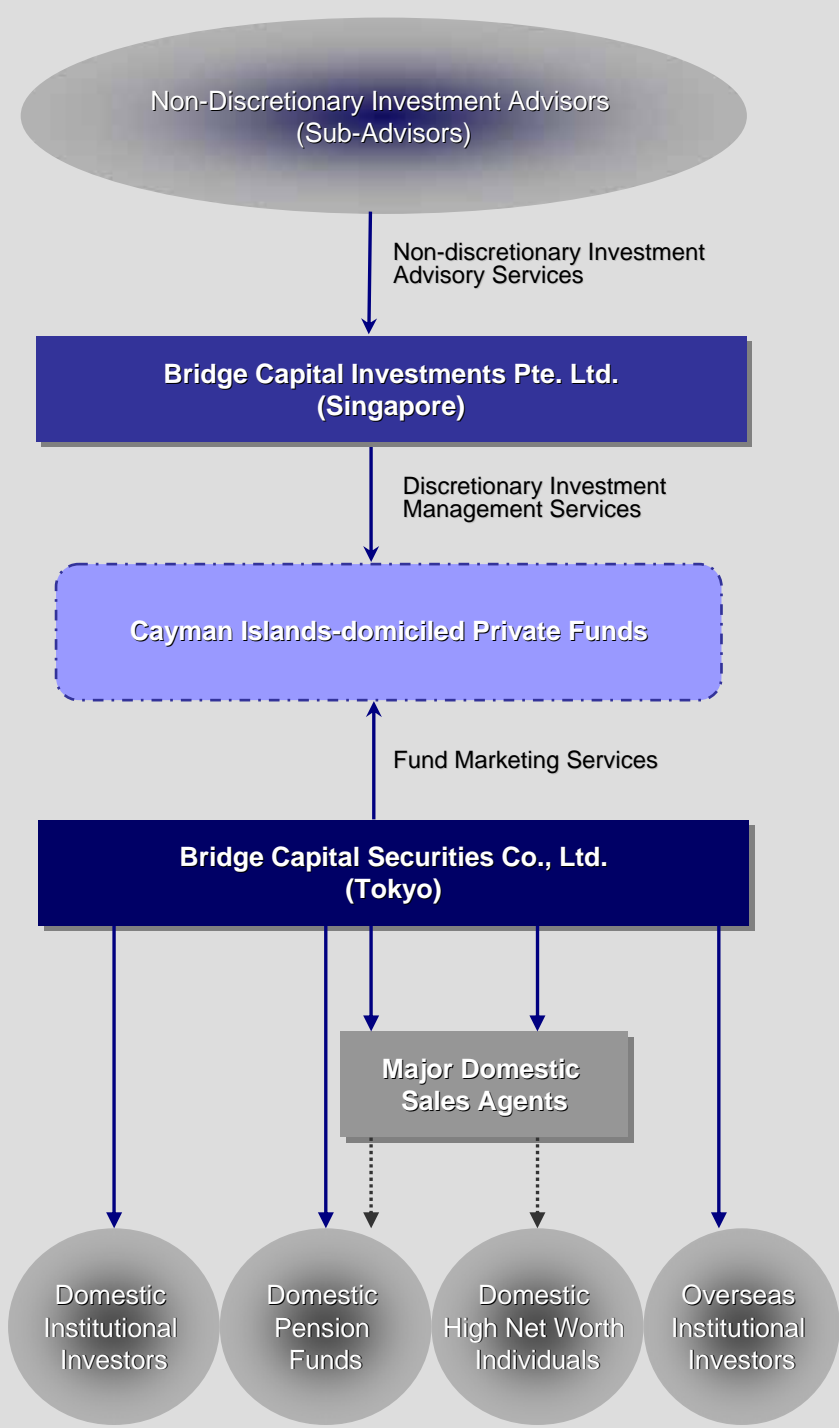

Toru Yamanaka, CEO & Director

Toru Yamanaka joined Bridge Capital Securities in 2005 and became CEO & Director of Bridge Capital Investments in 2005. Prior to this, Mr. Yamanaka co-founded a hedge fund research company Knights Capital and became its CEO in 2002. Previously, he was involved in the origination and management of the fund of funds business at Asahi Life Asset Management that he joined in 2000. Mr. Yamanaka started his career in Nomura Investment Management (currently, Nomura Asset Management) in 1988 where he was engaged in quantitative investment management and then selected for Nomura's Investment Management Training Program (IMT) in the U.S. Mr. Yamanaka holds a BS degree in Engineering from the Keio University, Japan.



Glendon Golanco, COO & Director

Glendon Golanco joined Bridge Capital Investments in 2005 as COO & Director since the firm's foundation. Prior to this, Mr. Golanco was Vice President and Head Operations & Accounting for high yield securities at Nomura Corporate Research & Asset Management (NCRAM) in New York, U.S., effectively responsible for high yield and emerging market hedge fund products (\$1.5bn).
