Item 2 - Educational Background and Business Experience

Mr. Clayton was born in 1948. He serves as a Financial Advisor and Branch Manager for Ziegler Wealth Management's (ZWM) Glen Allen, Virginia location. Mr. Clayton attended Harding University in Searcy, Arkansas where he earned a Bachelors in accounting. He has also attended the Wharton School of Business at the University of Pennsylvania and successfully earned a Morgan Stanley Senior Branch Manager designation. Mr. Clayton joined ZWM in 2011 and holds the position of Senior Vice President, Branch Manager/Financial Advisor. Prior to joining ZWM he was with Anderson & Strudwick, Inc. for ten months and held the position of Managing Director/Branch Manager. Prior to his time with Anderson & Strudwick, Inc. Mr. Clayton was a Vice President/Branch Manager for Ameriprise Financial, formally H&R Block Financial Advisors, for six years.

Item 3 - Disciplinary Information

In 1989, Mr. Clayton was the subject of an investment-related, consumer-initiated, written complaint, which alleged unsuitable investments, negligence and rule 405 violations causing \$180,000 in damages. The disposition was awarded to the customer by the arbitration panel. The awarded amount was \$235,000.00 which was paid by his employing firm Prudential Bache Securities.

In 1993, Mr. Clayton was the subject of an investment-related, consumer-initiated, written complaint, which resulted from the unprecedented unsolicited mailing of claim forms by PSI to over 340,000 investors who purchased limited partnerships through PSI. A client submitted a claim in response to this mailing. The claim was evaluated by PSI in accordance with the standards established under the settlement between PSI, the SEC, FINRA and the state securities administrators. The reported settlement arose out of this unique process. The matter was settled for \$16,671.00.

Item 4 - Other Business Activities

Mr. Clayton is not actively engaged in any other business activities.

Item 5 - Additional Compensation

Mr. Clayton may receive compensation in the form of commissions from the sale of investments in his capacity as a registered representative. Mr. Clayton may also receive compensation from insurance sales. Mr. Clayton does not receive any additional economic benefit from third parties for providing advisory services other than noted above.

Item 6 - Supervision
