Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	<p>The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Social Security number income account balances transaction history investment experience risk tolerance <p>When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.</p>
How?	All financial companies need to share consumers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their consumers' personal information; the reasons RE Advisers Corporation chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do	
How does RE Advisers Corporation protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings, as well as confidentiality agreements with companies we hire to help us provide services to you.
How does RE Advisers Corporation collect my personal information?	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • tell us about your investment or retirement portfolio • give us your income information • provide account information • give us your contact information <p>We do not collect personal information from others without your express authorization.</p>
Why can't I limit all sharing?	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness • affiliates from using information to market to you • sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</p>

Definitions	
Affiliates	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <p>Our affiliates include financial and nonfinancial companies, such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Homestead Funds, Inc.</i> • <i>RE Investment Corporation</i> • <i>National Rural Electric Cooperative Association</i> <p><i>RE Advisers Corporation does not share with affiliates so they can market to you.</i></p>

Nonaffiliates	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <p><i>RE Advisers Corporation does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.</i></p>
Joint Marketing	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <p><i>RE Advisers Corporation doesn't jointly market.</i></p>
