The basic requirements for participation in the CFA Program include holding or being in the final year of a university degree (or equivalent as assessed by CFA Institute), or having four years qualified, professional work experience in an investment decision-making process. To obtain the charter, however, a candidate must have completed a university degree (or equivalent) and four years of qualified, professional work experience, in addition to passing the three exam test that comprises the academic portion of the CFA program.

All three levels have a strong emphasis on ethics. The material differences among the exams are:

The Level I study program emphasizes tools and inputs, and includes an introduction to asset valuation, financial reporting and analysis and portfolio management techniques.

The Level II study program emphasizes asset valuation, and includes applications of the tools and inputs (including economics, financial reporting and analysis, and quantitative methods) in asset valuation.

The Level III study program emphasizes portfolio management, and includes strategies for applying tools and inputs, and asset valuation models in managing equity, fixed income, and derivative investments for individuals and institutions.
