Peter Van De Zilver also serves as a licensed Loan Originator at Home Source Mortgage, Inc. The compensation that Mr. Van de Zilver receives may vary. This activity is not investment-related and accounts for approximately 5% of Mr. Van de Zilver’s time. Interaction between Home Source Mortgage,

Inc. and Anfield clients is not anticipated. Therefore, it is not anticipated that this activity will present a material conflict of interest with Anfield clients.

Peter Van De Zilver also serves as a Portfolio Manager with Ostwind Pacific, a private trading operation which intends to form a hedge fund when research is complete and successful. This activity currently accounts for approximately 50% of Mr. Van de Zilver's time, but this percentage may vary. Once the fund is developed, Anfield clients may have the opportunity to invest and Ostwind Pacific may be compensated with a portion of the management fees.

ITEM 5 - ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION

Peter Van De Zilver also receives compensation for his work at Home Source Mortgage, Inc. and at Ostwind Pacific. Additionally, Anfield may pay Peter Van De Zilver a bonus at the firm's discretion. The bonus varies and is primarily based on the overall performance of Anfield whereby the amount of new accounts and client referrals may be used as a factor to determine the amount of the bonus.
