## **Item 2 - Educational Background and Business Experience**

**Eric Mandelblatt** – Born 1976. Mr. Mandelblatt is the Managing Partner and Chief Investment Officer of the Adviser. Prior to founding the Adviser in 2010, Mr. Mandelblatt was one of the Founding Partners and portfolio managers of TPG-Axon Capital Management, LP (“TPG-Axon”), a multi-billion dollar global investment firm. He joined TPG-Axon at launch in 2005 and was a member of TPG-Axon’s Investment & Management Committees. Mr. Mandelblatt started his career at Goldman, Sachs & Co. in 1998 as an equity research analyst covering the energy and power sectors. In 2002, Mr. Mandelblatt was hired into the Goldman Sachs Principal Strategies Group (formerly the Risk Arbitrage Department). He was promoted to Chief Operating Officer of the U.S. Principal Strategies business in 2004 and was a member of the Goldman Sachs Equity Division Risk Committee. His investment experience includes fundamentally driven equity long/short; capital structure arbitrage; distressed, commodity and volatility investing; and broader portfolio and risk management responsibilities. Mr. Mandelblatt serves, without compensation, as a board member of (i) The Williams Companies, Inc., (ii) the Ronald McDonald House, (iii) the University of Florida Investment Corporation and (iv) the Harlem Children’s Zone. Mr. Mandelblatt graduated with highest honors from the University of Florida with a BS in Accounting in 1998.

**Gaurav K. Kapadia** – Born 1981. Mr. Kapadia is the Co-Managing Partner of the Adviser. Prior to joining the Adviser in 2010, Mr. Kapadia was a Partner at TPG-Axon. He joined TPG-Axon prior to launch in 2004. In 2007, Mr. Kapadia moved to London to assist in building and launching TPG-Axon’s London Office and was involved in all aspects of building out TPG-Axon’s European presence. Mr. Kapadia has experience investing in the U.S., Europe, Asia and Latin America across a wide variety of industries and all parts of the capital structure. Mr. Kapadia started his career at the Boston Consulting Group as a strategy consultant.
