Mr. Buschbacher has extensive academic background and professional experience in financial and economic analysis, investment banking, finance, financial planning, multi-generation wealth planning, and private equity.

He recently founded, operated, and served as managing director of Red Top Financial Advisors, LLC, a Seattle based firm, until accepting the position of Managing Director, Investments, with Capital Privé Suisse, S.A.
