MOTION FOR EXTENSION

Rule 360(a)(3) specifies that in the event the administrative law judge assigned to a proceeding determines it is not possible to issue the initial decision within the time specified in the Order Instituting Proceedings ("OIP"), the judge should consult with the chief administrative law judge, who may petition the Securities and Exchange Commission ("Commission") for an extension. 17 C.F.R. § 201.360(a)(3).

This proceeding is on my docket. The OIP specified that an initial decision issue three hundred days from the date of service of the OIP, which is October 1, 2004. I request that the Commission extend the time for issuance of the Initial Decision by thirty days until November 1, 2004.

I am uncertain that I can issue the initial decision within the specified time because the case is complex, with a fairly sizeable record and multiple motions. Additionally, I have had to spend time on a hearing and dealing with multiple motions in another case, and have another three hundred day initial decision due on October 12, 2004.

For these reasons, I request that the Commission grant the motion for an extension. I will serve copies of this motion upon all persons on the service list as required by Rule 360(a)(3).
