ORDER POSTPONING
HEARING AND SCHEDULING
PREHEARING CONFERENCE

The Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) issued an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP) on October 31, 2013, alleging that Respondents have securities registered with the Commission pursuant to Section 12(g) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and have not filed periodic reports required by Section 13(a) of the Exchange Act and Exchange Act Rules 13a-1 and 13a-13. Respondents are required to answer within ten days of service of the OIP. See OIP at 4; 17 C.F.R. § 201.220(b).

On November 12, 2013, the Division of Enforcement (Division) filed the Declaration of David S. Frye to Assist Secretary with Record of Service (Declaration). The Declaration shows that all Respondents were served with the OIP by November 7, 2013. 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii), .(iv). On November 15, 2013, Klondike Star Mineral Corporation filed a “response” to the OIP, stating that it does not have the resources required to file the periodic reports, and requesting an immediate revocation of its registered securities. As of the date of this Order, no other Respondent has filed an Answer.

I POSTPONE the hearing scheduled for November 22, 2013, and ORDER a telephonic prehearing conference on that date at 2:00 p.m. EST. I will default any Respondent that does not file an Answer, attend the prehearing conference, or otherwise defend the proceeding. 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a), .220(f), .221(f).
