The Office of the Secretary has provided evidence that both Respondents were served with the OIP on November 26, 2013. Daniels filed an Answer to the OIP on December 12, 2013. Doxey's Answer to the OIP is due within twenty days after service of the OIP on him. See OIP at 5; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(b), .220(b).

For good cause shown, it is ORDERED that the hearing currently scheduled for December 31, 2013, is POSTPONED <u>sine</u> <u>die</u>, and a telephonic prehearing conference will be held on January 9, 2014, at 2:00 p.m. EST.
