The Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) issued Orders Instituting Proceedings in <u>Aguilera</u> on August 29, 2012, and in <u>Bresner</u> on September 10, 2012. Judge Cameron Elliot held seventeen days of hearing in <u>Bresner</u> and four days of hearing in <u>Aguilera</u>. Final briefs in both cases were submitted on May 10, 2013. An Initial Decision is due in Aguilera on July 1, 2013, and in Bresner on July 11, 2013.

Rule 360(a)(3) of the Commission's Rules of Practice provides that the Chief Administrative Law Judge may submit to the Commission a motion requesting an extension of the time period for filing an Initial Decision where she determines that it will not be possible to issue the Initial Decision in the time specified. 17 C.F.R. § 201.360(a)(3). That is true in this situation. I expect that <u>Aguilera</u> will be completed at, or very close to the due date, and request a thirty-day extension out of an abundance of caution. It is certain that Judge Elliot, who expects to begin a lengthy hearing on July 8, will need an additional ninety days to issue an Initial Decision in <u>Bresner</u>.
