The Securities and Exchange Commission issued its Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP) on March 19, 2013. The proceeding was stayed between March 27 and July 19, 2013. <u>Craig Berkman</u> <u>d/b/a Ventures Trust LLC</u>, Admin. Proc. File No. 3-15249 (A.L.J. July 19, 2013) (unpublished). John B. Kern (Kern) has filed an Answer to the OIP containing various motions for relief, including a motion for summary disposition.<sup>1</sup> Kern and the Division of Enforcement (Division) have requested that a prehearing conference be scheduled and that the time for Kern to request leave of the Administrative Law Judge to file any motions for summary disposition, and his time to file, supplement, or perfect any other prehearing motions, and the Division's time to respond to any such motions, be continued.

Accordingly, a prehearing conference will be held by telephone on Friday, September 13, 2013, at 2:00 p.m. EDT. The deadlines to file or reply to any prehearing motions are suspended and will be addressed at the prehearing conference. Pursuant to 17 C.F.R. § 201.250(a), a motion for summary

disposition can only be filed with leave of the Administrative Law Judge prior to completion of the Division's case in chief.
