ORDER POSTPONING HEARING AND
SCHEDULING PREHEARING
CONFERENCE

The Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) issued an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings (OIP) on August 20, 2013, alleging that these four Respondents have securities registered with the Commission pursuant to Section 12(g) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and that each has failed to file periodic reports required by Exchange Act Section 13(a) and Exchange Act Rules 13a-1 and/or 13a-13. Respondents are required to answer within ten days after service of the OIP. OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. § 201.220(b). On August 27, 2013, the Division of Enforcement filed the Declaration of Neil J. Welch, Jr., that shows G-Cats Acquisition Corp., GalaGen, Inc., and Garment Graphics, Inc. were served with the OIP by August 24, 2013. There has been no showing that Galena Acquisition Corp., allegedly located in Singapore, was served with the OIP. As of the date of this Order, no Respondent has filed an Answer. A hearing is scheduled to begin on September 24, 2013.

Order

On these facts, I POSTPONE the hearing, and ORDER a telephonic prehearing conference on September 24, 2013, at 2:00 p.m. EDT. I will default any Respondent served with the OIP who does not file an Answer, participate in the prehearing conference, or otherwise defend the proceeding. See 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a), .220(f), .221(f).
