ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE AND SCHEDULING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

The Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) issued an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings (OIP), pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, on September 19, 2013. The Office of the Secretary has provided evidence that the OIP was served on Respondent's registered agent, Nevada Agency and Transfer Company, as identified on the Nevada Secretary of State's website, by certified mail on September 23, 2013, in accordance with Rules 141(a)(2)(ii) and (iv) of the Commission's Rules of Practice. See 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii), (iv). Respondent's Answer was due within ten days of service of the OIP, or by October 7, 2013. See OIP at 2; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(b), .220(a), (b). To date, no Answer has been filed.

It is ORDERED that, on or before October 21, 2013, Respondent shall SHOW CAUSE why this proceeding should not be determined against it. <u>See</u> 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(2), .220(f). If Respondent fails to respond to this Order, it will be deemed in default, the proceeding will be determined against it, and the registration of its securities will be revoked. <u>See</u> 17 C.F.R. § 201.155(a)(2).

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the hearing scheduled for October 21, 2013, is postponed <u>sine die</u> and a telephonic prehearing conference shall be held on Monday, October 28, 2013, at 11:30 a.m. EDT.
