POSTPONEMENT ORDER

The Securities and Exchange Commission instituted this proceeding with an Order Instituting Proceedings on December 17, 2013, pursuant to Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Section 203(f) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940, and the hearing was scheduled to commence on January 21, 2014. The proceeding is a follow-on proceeding based on United States v. Anglin, No. 2:12-cr-232 (C.D. Cal. Mar. 25, 2013), in which Respondent Ronald Gene Anglin (Anglin) was convicted of mail fraud.

The Division of Enforcement, with the agreement of Anglin, has requested that the hearing be postponed and a prehearing conference scheduled on January 22, 2014, at 3:00 p.m. EST. Accordingly, consistent with 17 C.F.R. § 201.161, the hearing will be postponed sine die, and a prehearing conference will be held by telephone on January 22, 2014, at 3:00 p.m. EST.
