ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE AND SCHEDULING PREHEARING **CONFERENCE AS TO** GOOLU, INC.¹

The Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) issued an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings (OIP), pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, on August 6, 2013.

:

The Division of Enforcement provided evidence that the OIP was served on Goolu, Inc. (Goolu), on January 6, 2014, in accordance with Rules 141(a)(2)(ii) and (iv) of the Commission's Rules of Practice. See 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii), (iv). To date, Goolu has not filed an Answer, which was due within ten days after service of the OIP, or by January 22, 2014. See OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(b), .220(b).

It is ORDERED that on or before February 7, 2014, Goolu shall SHOW CAUSE why this proceeding should not be determined against it. See 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(2), .220(f). If Goolu fails to respond to this Order, it will be deemed in default, the proceeding will be determined against it, and the registrations of its securities will be revoked. See 17 C.F.R. § 201.155(a)(2).

It is FURTHER ORDERED that a telephonic prehearing conference will be held on February 24, 2014, at 10:00 a.m. EST, if the proceeding has not been resolved by then.
