The hearing in this proceeding is scheduled to commence on March 24, 2014, in Tampa, Florida. The Division of Enforcement (Division) has filed an unopposed motion, pursuant to 17 C.F.R. § 201.233 (Rule 233), for an order for deposition of Stephen Richards at his home in Camas, Washington, beginning at 9:00 a.m. on February 18, 2014, and, pursuant to 17 C.F.R. § 201.235 (Rule 235), for the admission into evidence of the transcript and video of the deposition in lieu of his live testimony at the hearing. The parties wish to do this because Mr. Richards is ill and unable to travel. The parties and Mr. Richards have agreed on the logistical arrangements for taking the deposition. The motion provided specifications as to the items in Rule 233(c)(1)-(5) for taking the deposition. Accordingly, the order for deposition will be granted as requested, pursuant to Rule 233, and the transcript and video of the deposition will be admissible into evidence, pursuant to Rule 235(a)(3).
