ORDER DESIGNATING PRESIDING JUDGE

The Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) has ordered, pursuant to Rule 100(c) of the Commission's Rules of Practice, that a public hearing shall be convened at a time and place to be fixed, and before an Administrative Law Judge, following the entry of a final judgment against the last remaining defendant in SEC v.
