ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE AND
CANCELING PREHEARING
CONFERENCE

The Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP) on April 16, 2014, pursuant to Section 15(b)(6) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. A telephonic prehearing conference is currently scheduled for May 19, 2014.

Respondent Kenneth C. Tebbs (Tebbs) was served with the OIP on April 21, 2014, and as of the date of this order, he had not filed his Answer, which was due by May 14, 2014. See OIP at 2; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.141(a)(2)(i), .160(b), .220(b).

Accordingly, it is ORDERED that Tebbs SHOW CAUSE by May 29, 2014, why this proceeding should not be determined against him for failing to file an answer to the OIP. If Tebbs fails to respond to this Order, file an Answer, or otherwise defend the proceeding, he will be deemed in default and the proceeding will be determined against him. See OIP at 2; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(2), .220(f).

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the May 19, 2014, telephonic prehearing conference is CANCELED.
