To allow time for service of the OIP and Chalmers's Answer, consistent with 17 C.F.R. § 201.161, the prehearing conference scheduled for June 27, 2014, will be postponed and held on July 25, 2014, at 10:30 a.m. EDT, if the proceeding has not been resolved by then.
