The Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) issued an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings (OIP) pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, on June 2, 2014, alleging that the named Respondents have securities registered with the Commission and have not filed required periodic reports. The OIP requires that Respondents answer the allegations within ten days of service of the OIP. OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. § 201.220(b). On June 6, 2014, the Division of Enforcement filed the Declaration of Neil J. Welch, Jr., to Assist Secretary with Record of Service (Declaration). The Declaration shows that Respondents were all served with the OIP on June 4, 2014, when delivery was either accomplished or attempted at an address on the Respondents' most recent Commission filings. 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii). On June 18, 2014, the Commission issued an Order Making Findings and Revoking Registration of Securities of International Paintball Association, Inc. Advanced Water Tech. Holdings, Inc., Exchange Act Release No. 72415, 2014 SEC LEXIS 2107. As of the date of this Order, no remaining Respondent has filed an answer, due on June 17, 2014, allowing an additional three days because service was by mail. 17 C.F.R. § 201.160(b).

Order

I POSTPONE the hearing scheduled to begin on June 30, 2014, and ORDER a telephonic prehearing conference at 11:00 a.m. EDT, on July 9, 2014. I will default any Respondent that does not file an answer, participate in the prehearing conference, or otherwise defend the proceeding. 17 C.F.R. § 201.155(a), .220(f), .221(f).
