POSTPONEMENT ORDER

The Securities and Exchange Commission instituted this proceeding with an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP) on June 10, 2014, pursuant to Section 203(f) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940, and the hearing was scheduled to commence on July 15, 2014. The proceeding is a follow-on proceeding based on <u>SEC v. Bard</u>, No. 1:09-cv-1473 (M.D. Pa. Nov. 10, 2011), in which Respondent Robert G. Bard (Bard), was enjoined against violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws.

Bard was served with the OIP in accordance with 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(i) on June 13, 2014. To allow time for Bard's Answer,¹ consistent with 17 C.F.R. § 201.161, the hearing will be postponed <u>sine die</u>, and a prehearing conference will be held by telephone on July 25, 2014, at 1:30 p.m. EDT if the proceeding has not been resolved by then.
