POST-HEARING ORDER

On November 13, 2013, the Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) issued an Order Instituting Administrative and Cease-and-Desist Proceedings against Julieann Palmer Martin (Martin) pursuant to Section 8A of the Securities Act of 1933, Sections 15(b) and 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and Section 9(b) of the Investment Company Act of 1940. A hearing was held on September 2 and 3, 2014, in Salt Lake City, Utah.

At the close of the hearing, I ordered the following schedule for post-hearing briefs:

October 6, 2014: The Division of Enforcement (Division) files its post-hearing brief.

October 23, 2014: Martin files her post-hearing brief.

November 10, 2014: The Division files its reply, if any.

The parties are requested to submit to my Office an electronic courtesy copy of the exhibits offered and admitted into evidence at the hearing. Also, the parties shall submit to my Office a list of the exhibits admitted into evidence and offered but not admitted. These submissions do not take the place of the required hard-copy filing of exhibits made with the Office of the Secretary pursuant to the Commission's Rules of Practice.
