ORDER POSTPONING HEARING, SCHEDULING PREHEARING CONFERENCE, AND TO SHOW CAUSE

On August 27, 2014, the Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) issued an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings (OIP) against Gold Horse International, Inc. (Gold Horse), pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act). The OIP alleges that Gold Horse has a class of securities registered with the Commission pursuant to Exchange Act Section 12(g) and is delinquent in its periodic filings, in violation of Exchange Act Section 13(a) and Rules 13a-1 and 13a-13 thereunder. A hearing is scheduled to commence on September 17, 2014.

On September 3, 2014, the Division of Enforcement filed the Declaration of David S. Frye to Assist Secretary with Record of Service, which reflects that Gold Horse's registered agent was served with the OIP by August 29, 2014, in accordance with Commission Rule of Practice 141(a)(2)(ii). See 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii). Gold Horse's Answer was due within ten days of service of the OIP plus an additional three days because service was effected by mail, or by Thursday, September 11, 2014. See OIP at 2; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(b), .220(b). As of today, Gold Horse has not filed an Answer.

Accordingly, it is ORDERED that on or before September 22, 2014, Gold Horse shall SHOW CAUSE why this proceeding should not be determined against it due to its failure to file an Answer or otherwise defend this proceeding. See 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(2), .220(f). If Gold Horse fails to respond to this Order, it shall be deemed in default, the proceeding will be determined against it, and the registration of its securities will be revoked. See OIP at 2; 17 C.F.R. § 201.155(a)(2).

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the hearing scheduled for September 17, 2014, is postponed *sine die*, and a telephonic prehearing conference shall be held on October 6, 2014, at 11:00 a.m. EDT, if the proceeding has not been resolved by then.
