ORDER POSTPONING HEARING AND SCHEDULING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

The Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Proceedings on September 2, 2014, pursuant to Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, against Respondent Jesse C. Litvak. A hearing is currently scheduled for October 6, 2014.

On September 18, 2014, the Division of Enforcement (Division) filed an Agreed Upon Motion to Schedule Initial Prehearing Conference and to Postpone Hearing Date (Motion). The Motion states that the Division and Respondent have conferred and propose October 6, 2014, at 9:30 a.m. EDT for a prehearing conference. Both parties agree that a postponement is appropriate to allow time for Respondent to file an Answer; both parties time to assess whether the proceeding may be resolved short of a hearing; and both parties additional time to prepare witnesses and organize exhibits for the hearing, if necessary. Motion at 1-2.

To allow time for Respondent to file an Answer, the Division's Motion is GRANTED. The hearing is POSTPONED *sine die*, and a telephonic prehearing conference is ORDERED for October 6, 2014, at 9:30 a.m. EDT.
