ORDER FOLLOWING
PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On September 15, 2014, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP) pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.

Respondents were served with the OIP by September 17, 2014, and their Answers were due on September 30, 2014. *Adarna Energy Corp.*, Admin Proc. Rulings Release No. 1871, 2014 SEC LEXIS 3705 (Oct. 1, 2014). On October 1, 2014, I issued an order notifying the parties that a telephonic prehearing conference would be held on October 10, 2014, and directing Respondents to show cause by October 10, 2014, why the registrations of their securities should not be revoked by default due to their failure to file Answers or otherwise defend this proceeding. *Id.* To date, no Respondent has filed an Answer.

At the telephonic prehearing conference held today, the Division of Enforcement appeared, but Respondents did not. During the conference, the Division reported that Respondent Mobile Area Networks, Inc., had recently filed deficient Forms 10-K and 10-Q.

Given the foregoing, the Division is ORDERED to file a memorandum by October 31, 2014, explaining whether Mobile Area Networks has filed all of its overdue reports and whether the reports that it has filed are deficient. The Division or Respondent Mobile Area Networks may file a motion for summary disposition by October 31, 2014. Any opposition to a motion for summary disposition will be due on November 21, 2014. If an opposition is filed, any reply to the opposition

will be due on December 5, 2014. If the Division elects to file a motion for summary disposition, it may submit its memorandum as part of its motion for summary disposition.
