The Securities and Exchange Commission instituted this proceeding with an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP) on September 22, 2014, pursuant to Sections 15(b) and 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Respondent Albert Reda (Respondent), and the hearing was scheduled to commence on October 28, 2014. On October 17, 2014, the Division of Enforcement (Division) advised that Respondent, who is incarcerated, has not yet been served with the OIP. The Division is taking steps to serve Respondent and requests that the hearing be postponed.

Consistent with 17 C.F.R. § 201.161, the hearing will be postponed *sine die*. The Division will report, by November 3, 2014, on the status of its efforts to serve Respondent. Once service has been achieved, a date and time for a telephonic prehearing conference will be set.
