ORDER POSTPONING HEARING AND SCHEDULING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

The Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) commenced this proceeding on October 28, 2014, with an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings (OIP) pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act). The OIP alleges that Respondents each have a class of securities registered with the Commission pursuant to Exchange Act Section 12(g) and are delinquent in their periodic filings, in violation of Exchange Act Section 13(a) and Rules 13a-1 and/or 13a-13. A hearing is scheduled to commence on November 18, 2014.

On November 3, 2014, the Division of Enforcement filed the Declaration of Neil J. Welch, Jr., to Assist Secretary with Record of Service, which reflects that all Respondents were served with the OIP by October 31, 2014, in accordance with Commission Rule of Practice 141(a)(2)(ii). See 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii). Respondents' answers are due within ten days of service of the OIP plus an additional three days because service was effected by mail, or by November 13, 2014. See OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(b), .220(b). No answers have been filed to date.

To allow time for any answers by Respondents, the November 18, 2014, hearing is POSTPONED *sine die*, and a prehearing conference is ORDERED for December 22, 2014, at 10:00 a.m. EST, if this proceeding is not resolved by then.
