ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS RULINGS

The Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) instituted this proceeding with an Order Instituting Proceedings on July 8, 2014, pursuant to Sections 8A of the Securities Act of 1933, 15(b) and 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, 203(f) and 203(k) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940, and 9(b) of the Investment Company Act of 1940. The hearing was scheduled to commence on November 17, 2014.

The parties have jointly moved to stay the hearing pursuant to 17 C.F.R. § 201.161(c)(2), stating that they have agreed in principle to a settlement that would resolve the proceeding and that Respondent Lawrence M. LaBine has already submitted a signed offer of settlement to Commission staff. Accordingly, the proceeding will be stayed, contingent upon compliance with 17 C.F.R. § 201.161(c)(2).
