ORDER POSTPONING HEARING AND SCHEDULING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

The Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) issued an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings (OIP) on November 17, 2014, alleging that YesDTC Holdings, Inc. (YesDTC), has securities registered with the Commission pursuant to Section 12(g) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and has not filed required periodic reports. The OIP requires that YesDTC answer within ten days after service of the OIP. OIP at 2; 17 C.F.R. § 201.220(b). A hearing is scheduled to begin on December 8, 2014.

United States Postal Service tracking information provided by the Commission's Office of the Secretary shows that YesDTC was served with the OIP on November 21, 2014, pursuant to Rule 141(a)(2)(ii) of the Commission's Rules of Practice, 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii). Accordingly, YesDTC must answer the OIP by December 4, 2014. *See* OIP at 2; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(b), .220(b).

I POSTPONE the hearing and schedule a telephonic prehearing conference at 2:00 p.m. EST on December 9, 2014. I will default YesDTC if it fails to answer the OIP, participate in the prehearing conference, or otherwise defend the proceeding. 17 C.F.R. § 201.155(a), .220(f), .221(f).
