ORDER POSTPONING
HEARING

On November 10, 2014, the Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) issued an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP) pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Respondents. A hearing is scheduled to commence on December 5, 2014.

On November 26, 2014, the Division of Enforcement filed a declaration reflecting that Respondents were served with the OIP by November 21, 2014, in accordance with Commission Rule of Practice 141(a)(2)(ii), 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii). Accordingly, Respondents must answer the OIP by December 4, 2014. *See* OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(b), .220(b).

It is ORDERED that: (1) to provide time for Answers, the hearing scheduled to begin on December 5, 2014, is POSTPONED *sine die*; (2) a telephonic prehearing conference shall be held at 11 a.m. EST on December 18, 2014, if the proceeding is not resolved by then; and (3) Respondents shall file their Answers to the OIP by December 4, 2014, *see* 17 C.F.R. § 201.220(c).
