ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

On November 13, 2014, the Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) issued an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings (OIP) against Respondents, pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The OIP alleges that Respondents each have a class of securities registered with the Commission and are delinquent in their periodic filings.

Respondents' Answers were due by December 1, 2014. *See BlueSky Filing Corp.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 2046, 2014 SEC LEXIS 4449 (Nov. 24, 2014) (citing OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(b), .220(b)). To date, no Respondent has filed an Answer.

Accordingly, I ORDER that on or before Monday, December 15, 2014, Respondents shall SHOW CAUSE why this proceeding should not be determined against them due to their failure to file Answers or otherwise defend this proceeding. Any Respondent that fails to respond to this Order will be deemed in default, the proceeding will be determined against it, and the registration of its securities will be revoked. *See* OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(2), .220(f).
