ORDER ON MOTION TO ADMIT DECLARATION AND PRIOR TESTIMONY

The Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Cease-and-Desist Proceedings (OIP) on September 30, 2014, pursuant to Section 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, against Respondent Jordan Peixoto. A hearing is scheduled to commence on March 16, 2015.

On November 25, 2014, the Division of Enforcement (Division) filed a motion (Motion), seeking leave to offer the recent Fifth Amendment declaration of Filip Szymik in lieu of live testimony at the hearing, and for admission of Szymik's November 18, 2013, sworn SEC testimony. On December 2, 2014, Respondent's counsel informed this Office by email that they would not oppose the Motion.

Accordingly, the Motion is GRANTED, and the Division may offer at the hearing Szymik's Fifth Amendment declaration and Szymik's November 18, 2013, sworn SEC testimony.
