ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE AND POSTPONEMENT

On November 10, 2014, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP) pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Respondents. A prehearing conference is scheduled for December 18, 2014.

Respondents' Answers to the OIP were due by December 4, 2014. *See AARX, Inc.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 2069, 2014 SEC LEXIS 4528 (Dec. 1, 2014) (citing OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(b), .220(b)). As of today, no Respondent has filed an Answer.

Accordingly, it is ORDERED that on or before December 18, 2014, Respondents shall SHOW CAUSE why this proceeding should not be determined against them due to their failures to file Answers or otherwise defend this proceeding. *See* 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(2), .220(f). If any Respondent fails to respond to this Order, it shall be deemed in default, the proceeding will be determined against it, and the registration of its securities will be revoked. *See* OIP at 4; 17 C.F.R. § 201.155(a)(2), .220(f). It is FURTHER ORDERED that the telephonic prehearing conference scheduled for December 18, 2014, is POSTPONED to December 30, 2014, at 10:00 a.m. EST.
