PREHEARING ORDER

The Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) instituted this proceeding with an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP) on June 12, 2014, and amended the OIP on November 19, 2014, as a follow-on proceeding based on *SEC v. Yang*, No. 12-cv-2473 (N.D. Ill. May 27, 2014), *appeal docketed* (7th Cir. July 24, 2014), in which Siming Yang (Yang), was enjoined against violations of the antifraud and reporting provisions of the federal securities laws. Yang has filed an Answer to the amended OIP.

Previously, the Division of Enforcement (Division) was granted leave, pursuant to 17 C.F.R. § 201.250, to file a motion for summary disposition, due October 6, 2014, with Yang's opposition and the Division's reply due November 3 and November 10, 2014, respectively. *Siming Yang*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 1768, 2014 SEC LEXIS 3224 (A.L.J. Sept. 5, 2014). These dates were suspended because the Division requested the Commission to amend the OIP. *Id.* The Division's motion for summary disposition will now be due January 26, 2015; Yang's opposition and the Division's reply will be due February 23 and March 2, 2015, respectively.
