ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS RULINGS Release No. 2196/January 8, 2015

The Securities and Exchange Commission instituted this proceeding with an Order Instituting Proceedings, pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act), on September 29, 2014. The OIP alleges that Respondent is a corporation with a class of securities registered with the Commission pursuant to Section 12(g) of the Exchange Act and has repeatedly failed to file required periodic reports.

On December 12, 2014, I held a prehearing conference, at which both parties appeared, and adopted a summary disposition schedule requiring the Division of Enforcement (Division) to file a motion for summary disposition by January 9, 2015, Respondent to file an opposition by January 23, 2015, and the Division to file a reply by January 30, 2015. On January 8, 2015, both parties jointly notified this Office that they are close to resolving this matter by consent, and therefore jointly request that the summary disposition schedule be postponed.

In light of the parties' joint request to reschedule the summary disposition schedule in order to reach an amicable resolution to this case, it is ORDERED that the following summary disposition schedule is adopted: the Division's motion for summary disposition will be due on January 16, 2015; Respondent's opposition and the Division's reply will be due January 23 and January 30, 2015, respectively.
