On November 14, 2014, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings (OIP) against Respondent pursuant to Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and a Notice of Hearing and Order of Suspension pursuant to Rule 102(e)(2) of the Commission's Rules of Practice.

On December 4, 2014, the Division of Enforcement submitted a Motion to Postpone Hearing representing that it had no evidence that proper service of the OIP had been effected on Respondent. I granted the Division's request that the scheduled hearing be postponed. *Douglas L. Swenson*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 2102, 2014 SEC LEXIS 4687 (Dec. 5, 2014). On January 7, 2015, the Division filed a Notice of Service representing that Respondent was served via personal service, in accordance with Commission Rule of Practice 141(a)(2)(i), 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(i), on December 30, 2014. Accordingly, Respondent's answer is due on January 20, 2015. *See* OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(a), .220(b).
