In the Matter of ORDER CANCELING PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND SCHEDULING STATUS UPDATES

On September 10, 2014, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Cease-and-Desist Proceedings against Ligang Wang pursuant to Section 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. A prehearing conference was held on October 8, 2014, at which the Division of Enforcement stated that service of Mr. Wang was underway in accordance with the Hague Convention on the Service Abroad of Judicial and Extrajudicial Documents in Civil or Commercial Matters. *Ligang Wang*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 1901, 2014 SEC LEXIS 3799 (Oct. 9, 2014). I ordered that a second telephonic prehearing conference be held on February 5, 2015, to discuss the status of service of Mr. Wang. *Id*.

On January 28, 2015, the Division informed this Office that it has not yet received confirmation of service on Mr. Wang, and proposed sending an update by March 6, 2015, with any information it is able to obtain on the status of service.

Accordingly, it is ORDERED that the telephonic prehearing conference scheduled for February 5, 2015, is CANCELED, and it is FURTHER ORDERED that the Division shall update this Office on the status of service on Mr. Wang by March 6, 2015, via email to alj@sec.gov, and every three months thereafter until service is effected, at which time it shall promptly file a declaration of service.
