The Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) commenced this proceeding on December 3, 2014, with an Order Instituting Administrative and Cease-and-Desist Proceedings pursuant to Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) Sections 4C and 21C and Commission Rule of Practice 102(e).<sup>1</sup> Yesterday, I received third-party Assisted Living Concepts, LLC's (ALC) Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time for ALC to Move to Quash or Modify Subpoena (Motion).<sup>2</sup> The Motion represents that ALC has conferred with the Division of Enforcement and counsel for Respondent Laurie Bebo, and neither has an objection to such an extension.

For good cause shown, the Motion is GRANTED and ALC has until February 20, 2015, to move to quash or modify the subpoena served on it on January 28, 2015. *See* 17 C.F.R. § 201.161(b).
