The Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Administrative and Cease-and-Desist Proceedings (OIP) on January 15, 2015. A telephonic prehearing conference was held on February 10, 2015, at which the Division of Enforcement confirmed that Respondent John Briner, Esq. was served by January 21, 2015. Mr. Briner's Answer was therefore due by February 13, 2015. *See* OIP at 28; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160, .220(b). Mr. Briner did not attend the prehearing conference and has not filed an Answer.

Accordingly, it is ORDERED that on or before March 2, 2015, Respondent John Briner, Esq. shall SHOW CAUSE why this proceeding should not be determined against him for failing to file an Answer, attend the prehearing conference, or otherwise defend this proceeding. *See* OIP at 28-29; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a), .220(f), .221(f).
