ORDER POSTPONING HEARING AND SCHEDULING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On February 6, 2015, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP) against Jordon McCarty, pursuant to Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. A hearing is currently scheduled for March 9, 2015.

On February 25, 2015, the Division of Enforcement filed a motion to convert the scheduled hearing into a telephonic prehearing conference. With its motion, the Division also included evidence showing that Mr. McCarty was served with the OIP by February 18, 2015, in accordance with Rule of Practice 141(a)(2)(i). See 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(i). Therefore, Mr. McCarty's Answer is due by Friday, March 13, 2015, as service was effected by mail. OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(a)-(b), .220(b).

Accordingly, I ORDER that the hearing scheduled to begin on March 9, 2015, is POSTPONED and a telephonic prehearing conference shall be held that same day at 3:00 p.m. EDT.
