STAY ORDER AS TO THREE
RESPONDENTS

This proceeding was instituted with an Order Instituting Proceedings on January 23, 2015. A telephonic prehearing conference is scheduled for April 7, 2015.

On March 26, 2015, the Division of Enforcement (Division) and Respondents David B. Havanich, Jr., Carmine A. DellaSala, and Matthew D. Welch (collectively, Settling Respondents) filed a joint motion representing that each Settling Respondent has reached a settlement in principle with the Division and provided the Division with a signed offer of settlement.

For good cause shown and consistent with 17 C.F.R. § 201.161(c)(2), the proceeding is STAYED as to Settling Respondents.¹ The Division shall promptly notify the undersigned if any requirement of 17 C.F.R. § 201.161(c)(2) is not met.
