ALTERNATE ENERGY SOLUTIONS, INC., BUTLER INTERNATIONAL, INC., CHEVAL RESOURCES CORP., and SCORPION PERFORMANCE, INC. ORDER POSTPONING HEARING AND SCHEDULING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On March 17, 2015, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings (OIP) against Respondents pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. A hearing is scheduled to commence on April 7, 2015.

On March 20, 2015, the Division of Enforcement filed a Declaration of Service asserting that Respondents were served with the OIP on March 18, 2015, by mailing the OIP by Priority Mail Express to Respondents' most recent addresses shown on each entity's most recent filing with the Commission. *See* 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii). I find that Butler International, Inc., Cheval Resources Corp., and Scorpion Performance, Inc., were served on March 18, 2015, in accordance with Commission Rule of Practice 141(a)(2)(ii), and their Answers are due by March 31, 2015.<sup>1</sup> 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii); OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. § 201.220(b).

The Declaration states that the Commission's Office of the Secretary mailed the OIP to Alternate Energy Solutions, Inc., at the address shown on its most recent EDGAR filing of 1601 Highway 92N, Fayetteville, GA 30214. The address shown on Alternate Energy's most recent filing, a Form 10-Q for the quarter ended March 31, 2012, is 1061 Highway 92 N, Fayetteville, GA 30214. I find that Alternate Energy was not served in accordance with Rule 141(a)(2)(ii), 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii).

The address shown on Scorpion's most recent EDGAR filing, a notification of late filing of Form 10-Q for the quarter ended June 30, 2012, is 5817 NW 44<sup>th</sup> Ave., Ocala, FL 34482. The discrepancy in address in the Declaration appears to be a typo as the service address attached to the OIP and in the Office of the Secretary's records demonstrate that the OIP was sent to 5817 NW 44<sup>th</sup> Ave., Ocala, FL 34482.

To allow time for service on Alternate Energy and Answers, the April 7, 2015, hearing is POSTPONED *sine die*. A prehearing conference will be scheduled after the Division files an updated declaration of service once service has been effected as to Alternate Energy Solutions, Inc.
