On October 27, 2014, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Administrative and Cease-and-Desist Proceedings against Respondent Thrasos Tommy Petrou (Petrou), pursuant to Section 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Section 203(f) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940.

On March 20, 2015, I granted in part and denied in part the motions for summary disposition filed by Petrou and the Division of Enforcement (Division), finding three issues regarding which there continues to exist a genuine issue of material fact. *Thrasos Tommy Petrou*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 2446, 2015 SEC LEXIS 1027. A telephonic prehearing conference was held on March 30, 2015, attended by the Division and Petrou's counsel.

During the conference, the parties agreed to the following schedule for supplemental briefing addressing any of the three remaining issues identified in my March 20, 2015, order:

April 24, 2015: Supplemental opening briefs are due;

May 8, 2015: Oppositions are due.
