ORDER POSTPONING
HEARING AND SCHEDULING
PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On March 12, 2015, the Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) issued an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings (OIP) against Albert J. Scipione, pursuant to Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. A hearing is currently scheduled for April 6, 2015.

On March 31, 2015, the Division of Enforcement (Division) filed a motion to convert the scheduled hearing into a telephonic prehearing conference to be held on April 20, 2015. In its motion, the Division represented that Respondent had refused service of the OIP by mail and that moving the prehearing conference to a later date would allow time for service of the OIP by other means. Accordingly, I POSTPONE the hearing scheduled to begin on April 6, 2015, and ORDER a telephonic prehearing conference to be held on April 27, 2015, at 10:00 a.m. EDT.
