ORDER POSTPONING HEARING

See 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii). The Declaration does not assert that Beyond Golden Holdings Ltd. has been served.

To allow time for service on Beyond Golden Holdings and Answers from all five Respondents, the April 29, 2015, hearing is POSTPONED sine die. A prehearing conference will be scheduled after the Division files a declaration of service as to Beyond Golden Holdings.
