ORDER RESCHEDULING
PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On March 12, 2015, the Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) issued an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings (OIP) against Albert J. Scipione, pursuant to Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. A telephonic prehearing conference is scheduled for April 27, 2015.

On April 23, 2015, the Division filed a motion to postpone the telephonic prehearing conference by two weeks due to its inability to serve Respondent with the OIP. The Division represents that Respondent recently reported to prison to serve his sentence in a related criminal proceeding, and that the Division has undertaken steps to serve Respondent in prison.

For good cause shown and consistent with 17 C.F.R. § 201.161, I POSTPONE the prehearing conference scheduled to begin on April 27, 2015, and ORDER a telephonic prehearing conference to be held on May 14, 2015, at 10:00 a.m. EDT.
