ORDER GRANTING MOTION
TO EXTEND TIME TO ANSWER

The Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) issued an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP) on March 25, 2015, alleging that Winsonic Digital Media Group, Ltd. (Winsonic), has securities registered with the Commission and has not filed required periodic reports. At a prehearing conference on April, 16, 2015, I ordered certain procedural deadlines, including that Winsonic should file an answer to the allegations in the OIP by May 1, 2015. *Winsonic Digital Media Grp., Ltd.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 2552, 2015 SEC LEXIS 1423 (April 16, 2015).

On May 1, 2015, Winsonic emailed this Office a Motion to Extend Time to Answer, requesting an extension to file its answer by May 6, 2015 (Motion). Winsonic represents that the Division of Enforcement consents to the Motion.

I GRANT the Motion. Winsonic's Answer is due by May 6, 2015. Failure to file an Answer may result in Winsonic being deemed in default. 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a), .220(f).
