ORDER GRANTING THIRD MOTION TO EXTEND TIME TO ANSWER

The Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) issued an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP) on March 25, 2015, alleging that Winsonic Digital Media Group, Ltd. (Winsonic), has securities registered with the Commission and has not filed required periodic reports. At a prehearing conference on April 16, 2015, I ordered certain procedural deadlines, including that Winsonic file an Answer to the allegations in the OIP by May 1, 2015. *Winsonic Digital Media Grp.*, *Ltd.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 2552, 2015 SEC LEXIS 1423.

On May 4, 2015, I granted Winsonic's motion to extend the due date for its Answer to May 6, 2015. Winsonic Digital Media Grp., Ltd., Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 2626, 2015 SEC LEXIS 1698. On May 7, 2015, I granted Winsonic's second motion to extend the due date for its Answer to May 13, 2015. Winsonic Digital Media Grp., Ltd., Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 2642, 2015 SEC LEXIS 1751. On May 13, 2015, Winsonic emailed this Office a third Motion to Extend Time to Answer (Third Motion) that it is filing with the Office of the Secretary, requesting that its Answer be due by May 20, 2015, to allow time to make an offer of settlement. Winsonic represents that the Division of Enforcement consents to the Third Motion.

I GRANT the Third Motion. Winsonic's Answer is due by May 20, 2015. Failure to file an Answer may result in Winsonic being deemed in default. 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a), .220(f).
